INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

The interested consultancy firms having experience of similar nature works may apply for selection alongwith the following information / particulars, duly supported with necessarily documents:

- 1. Name of firm / address of the registered office with telephone / fax number and e-mail address including organization chart showing management structure. In case of JV, provide information of all JV members. Format for letter of EOI application as per **Appendix-1**.
- 2. Certificate of incorporation/ constitution of the firm as legal entity. In case of JV / association / consortium / sub consultants, provide information of all firms.
- 3. Firm(s)/ joint venture(s) name, address, copy of the Registration Certificates with relevant/concerned regulatory bodies/authority of the origin country.
- 4. Firm or in case of JV/association/consortium the Lead/local Partner must be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) for the year 2022 and Securities & Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP).
- 5. In case of JV/association/consortium, lead/local partner shall have Fifty-One (51%) or more shares in JV/association/consortium.
- 6. Firm or in case of JV/association/consortium the lead partner must be registered with Federal Board of Revenue.
- 7. Firm or in case of JV/association/consortium, if lead partner is unregistered with Punjab Revenue Authority (PRA), as per Rule 6 of Punjab Sales Tax Special Procedure (withholding rules) 2015, the withholding agent shall deduct tax on gross value as per applicable rates of tax for all unregistered persons.

- 8. Memorandum/Article of Association/ Partnership Deed or Joint Venture Agreement (as applicable).
- 9. Company profile, ownership and organizational structure of the consultant.
- 10. Only relevant Project wise experience with time duration for each Project.
- 11. List of similar works completed by the Firm during the last 10-years, indicating total cost of such works and cost of Consultancy Services received against those works along with date of start and completion of expected date of completion. The Bidder should furnish details of technical experience of the Firm as on the date of submission of EOI as per **Appendix-2**.
- 12. An undertaking by the consultants / firms / JVs to the effect that "Neither the firm / consultants / JVs nor its Directors / Stakeholders, as a whole or as a part of the firm have even been Black-listed / defaulted by any Government Agency / Department / Organization and also that the information supplied by the consultants / firm / JVs is correct".
- 13. Certificate / Affidavit that the consultants / firms /JVs is not in litigation with any client.
- 14. Superfluous / irrelevant information shall lead to disqualification.
- 15. All the Consultants are allowed to participate in the subject procurement without regard to nationality, except consultants of some nationality, prohibited in accordance with policy of the Government. Ministry of Interior, Government of Pakistan has notified List of Business-Friendly Countries (BVL), Latest information may be confirmed from the relevant quarter.
- 16. Audit Statement of account for the last 03-years including the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account of the Bidder (of each member in case of a consortium).
- 17. Any firm either individual or joint venture partner or any person employee of firm involved / participated directly or indirectly in design and review of R3 Project shall not be eligible to participate in instant TPV directly/ indirectly, as a JV partner or individually.
- 18. Details of net worth, annual turnover & net cash accruals duly filled and signed as per **Appendix-4**.
- 19. Maximum three (03) number of firms are allowed to make JV / consortium. The same firm shall not be allowed to submit EOI individually and in JV with any other firm. Every JV shall be unique. For international firms, it is mandatory to make JV / consortium with local firm/firms.



- 20. List of permanent professional staff along with CVs of relevant core staff showing relevant project wise experience with exact time duration for each project. The Bidder should furnish details of technical experience of core team/ professional staff as on the date of submission of EOI as per Appendix-3.
- 21. Interested firms may obtain Pre-Qualification Documents (PQD), on request from the office of Deputy Project Director, Project Management Unit, Commissioner's Office, Katchehry Chowk, Rawalpindi by paying of Rs. 2000/- in RDA Account. Section B.

BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK

1 BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

1.1 Project Brief

Rawalpindi is the capital city of Rawalpindi Division located in the Punjab Province of Pakistan. Rawalpindi is 3rd largest city of Punjab after Lahore and Faisalabad respectively, while the larger Islamabad-Rawalpindi metropolitan area is the country's fourth largest metropolitan area. Rawalpindi is adjacent to Pakistan's capital of Islamabad, and the two are jointly known as the "twin cities" on account of strong social and economic links between the cities.

The first Master Plan of greater Rawalpindi was prepared during 1969 and was adopted in 1978 for implementation. Unfortunately, the plan was never put into operation due to delayed process for approval and limited scope for preservation of city structure lines. Resultantly, haphazard sprawl of the urban structure and mushroom growth of private housing schemes towards eastern and western side of Rawalpindi has taken place in an uncontrolled way. As of now the traffic on G.T. road (National Highway, N-5) from Lahore to Rawalpindi/Islamabad & to Peshawar and vice-versa is compelled to pass through heart of the City and this traffic combined with the local slow moving vehicles results in high traffic congestion. Further, the integration of Capital Islamabad & Rawalpindi has further aggravated the traffic situation. The quantum of registered vehicles in Rawalpindi & Islamabad is increasing day by day.

The development of new neighborhood towards southern side of Rawalpindi is also under influence of this traffic and congestion free route is needed. By implication, the development of Rawalpindi Ring Road (RRR)/bypass is exceedingly inevitable to complete the city network according to Traffic & Transportation Plan of Twin Cities. Earlier in the year 1997, the feasibility study was prepared by Rawalpindi Development Authority (RDA) on Build-on-Operate-Transfer (BOOT).

After completing the spade work, Proposals on BOOT basis from local and international investors were invited in 1999. But the project was stalled due to extraneous circumstances. RDA redesigned the project in 2008 on PPP concept.

In 2017, Rawalpindi Development Authority (RDA) engaged M/s NESPAK & JV as Transaction Advisor (TA) to prepare RRR project proposal on Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode. M/s NESPAK and JVs submitted the proposal which included alignment starting from Banth (N-5) and terminating at Thallian (M-2). The total length including 38.3 km main carriageway (3+3) road alignment with optional links of 12.5 km Rawat Link (2+2) road and (6.5 km) rehabilitation of Fateh Jang road(National Highway N-80) and Girja road (1.5). (Alignment 2017)

In 2018/19, Government of the Punjab decided to execute the RRR project through Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) loan so RDA engaged M/s Zeeruk Int, with JV in Sept 2019 for feasibility study and detailed design of RRR project on alignment proposed by the M/s NESPAK & JV in 2017. M/s Zeeruk and JV revised the alignment from Radio Pakistan Towers located at National Highway N-5 to Sangjani (N-5) (65 Km) b crossing the Motorway M-2 at Murat. After that it is bypassing the Islamabad International Airport. It then utilizes the CPEC section by adding additional two lanes on both sides of CPEC section up to Hakla Interchange at Motorway M-1. It then utilizes the existing paswal road and terminates at Sangjhani on National Highway N-5 with connection to Margalla road. M/s Zeeruk alignment excluded optional Rawat Link road & rehabilitation of Fateh Jang road and extended the RRR beyond M-2 Motorway to connect with CPEC, M-1 and N-5. Consequently, M/S NESPAK prepared a PPP proposal on the M/S ZeeruK Proposed Alignment. (Alignment 2020)

Later on, Government of the Punjab ordered a fact-finding inquiry for on the allegation of change in route of the Rawalpindi Ring. Consequently, Government of the Punjab decided to execute the project on Public Sector.

Funding through Annual Development Programme of Government of Punjab and adopted M/s NESPAK & JV proposed alignment in 2017 excluding the optional Links. (Alignment 2021), M/s ECSP was engaged to update the M/s NESPAK 2017 studies for the preparation of PC-I and finally the project was approved by the ECNEC. After that, M/s NESPAK was hired for detailed design and consequently tender was floated and LOI was issued to M/s FWO.

In July-2020, Planning & Development Board, Punjab directed the RDA on the basis of directive issued by the Prime minister of Pakistan to conduct third party validation of all previous alignments i.e. 2017, 2020 and 2021for the determination of optimal route alignment.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSIGNMENT:

A comparative analysis based on technical, financial/economic and legal parameters of three routes/alignments presented in the past in the years 2017, 2020 & 2021 shall be made with the help of the engineering consultants, Financial/Economic and Legal experts in order to determine the optimal route for the RRR project. The analysis is based on the legal, technical, financial/economic, environmental review of each alignment.

3. PROCUREMENT METHOD &TYPE OF CONTRACT:

Quality and Cost based Method as per PPRA Rules and man months based contract with Payment schedule of fee as per agreement based on deliverables.

4. DURATION

The duration is two (02) months for this assignment.

For the purpose of Evaluation, the Bidder (a single entity or a consortium) should demonstrate the Threshold Financial Capability of the firm by providing supporting documents, which shall include the following details:

- i. Turnover in each of the last three financial years.
- ii. Net worth as on June 30, 2022 as certified by the Registered Chartered Accountant as per the law of the origin country.
- iii. Average Annual Net Cash during the last three (3) financial years.
- iv. Single entity bidder and all members of the consortium, if applicable, should be profit-making concerns for the last 3 years.
- v. Details of net worth, annual turnover & net cash accruals duly filled and signed as per Appendix-4.

Note:

- ☐ Average annual turnover in last 3 accounting years less than 200 million will be considered non-responsive.
- ☐ Companies Net Worth less than 100 million will be considered non-responsive.

1.2 Special Condition in case of JV/Consortium

In case of JV/consortium, lead firm must have minimum of 51% shares and other firms have at least 20% shares in consortium. Percentage of shares of each firm must be clearly mentioned.

In case the Bidder is a Consortium, turnover, net worth and net cash accruals would be taken as an arithmetic sum of net worth, turnover and net cash accruals of each member of the Consortium, calculated in the ratio of their share in the consortium. The Consortium would be required to meet the threshold criteria on the basis of aggregate figures subject to provisions of this Clause.



In case the Bidder claims the technical and/or financial capacity of Bidder's companies/associates, the bidder shall necessarily submit documentary evidence i.e. proof of such claims. Such documentary evidence shall consist of CA certificates to support such capacity.

2. COMPANY'S/JV TECHNICAL EXPERIENCE (20 marks)

2.1 Number and relative size of similar assignments:

- I. At least One (01) similar consultancy work (detailed third party validation of Highway/Motorway) must be carried out by the firm in last 10 years. Maximum marks for the project shall be 10.
- II. Motorways / highways and at-least two (02) completed assignments pertaining to feasibility and detailed design of Motorways / highways will be evaluated each carrying equal marks (i.e.5). Maximum marks for two projects shall be 10.
- III. Only completed assignments shall be evaluated. The consultant shall furnish completion/ completion report of completed assignments for technical evaluation.
- IV. In case of JV/association/consortium relevant completed assignments will be evaluated in aggregate.

2.2 Marking Criteria for Company Experience:

2.3 Evaluation of Technical Experience of the firm

The Bidder which could be single entity or the JV/consortium shall be evaluated on the following:

- i. Projects completed during the last ten years shall only be considered. Only eligible projects shall be considered for estimation of technical experience. Irrelevant projects shall be scored Zero.
- ii. Experience of similar assignments in scope and scale (either individually or as a consortium member);
- iii. Professional capability of the Bidder such as availability of qualified and experienced managerial and diverse technical professionals and the Bidder should furnish details of technical experience of the Firm as on the date of submission of EOI as per **Appendix-2**.
