RDA's Enforcement Squad Removes Building Material on Dhamyal Kalyal Road and Girja Road.

RAWALPINDI, September 4, 2024: On the directives of the Chief Minister of Punjab, Maryam Nawaz Sharif, Rawalpindi Development Authority (RDA) has taken ground-breaking steps and Special Enforcement Squad RDA is continuously removing encroachments in the Rawalpindi city to protect and beautify the environment, a spokesperson RDA informed.
